## Information for Year 6

### Homework & Spellings

**Homework is due in every Thursday.**

The children will be given their new homework every Friday.

If your child fails to complete their homework, they will miss golden time on Friday and complete it then. Spellings will be given out every Monday and tested the following Monday.

### PE

Our PE lessons will take place every **Monday (outdoor)** and **Thursday (indoor)**.

### SATS
