Information for Year 6

Homework & Spellings

Homework is due in every Wednesday.

The children will be given their new homework every Thursday. If your child fails to complete their homework for Thursday, they will miss golden time on Friday and complete it then. Spellings will be given out every Monday and tested the following Monday.

PE

Our PE lessons will take place every **Tuesday (outdoor) and Friday (indoor).**

Children **MUST** come to school **wearing** their PE kits on these days. This can only be black shorts/joggers and a plain white top. They can wear their school jumper and trainers.

SATS

The government has confirmed that SATs will still go ahead in 2021.
