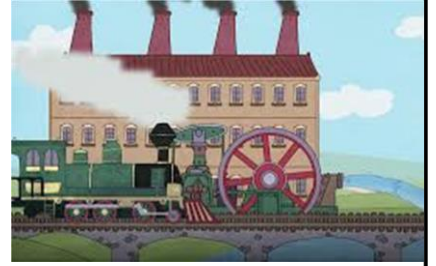

Key facts

- Victoria was crowned when she was only 18 years old.
- Through invasion and colonisation, Britain became the most powerful empire in world history.
- The Industrial Revolution meant that more people lived in cities than in the countryside for the first time.
- Children were often made to work dangerous jobs, such as chimney sweeps.
- Healthcare improved and hospitals became more hygienic.
- Railways meant that several major cities were connected, allowing people to travel faster than ever before.
