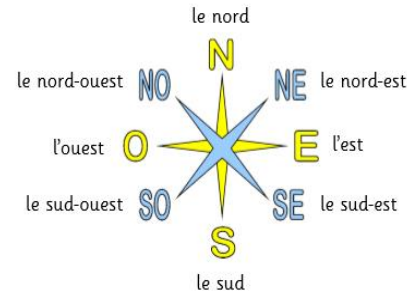
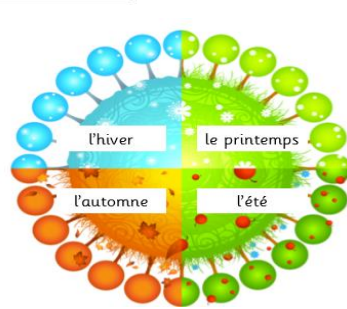
How do you use it?
