Information for Year 6

Homework & Spellings

Homework is due in every Wednesday.

The children will be given their new homework (on Showbie) every Thursday at 4:00pm. If your child fails to complete their homework for Thursday they will miss golden time on Friday and complete it then.

Spellings will be given out every Monday (again on Showbie) and tested the following Monday.

PE

Our PE lessons will take place every **Tuesday (outdoor)** and **Wednesday (indoor)**.

Children **MUST** come to school **in** their PE kits on these days. This can only be black shorts/joggers and a plain white top. They can wear their school jumper and trainers.

SATS

The government has confirmed that SATs will still go ahead in 2021. The date for SATs is Monday 10th May 2021 – Thursday 13th May 2021. Your child's writing will be assessed by the 28th June. Please do not book any holidays in the run up to SATs and the writing assessment.

Residential

The children who have paid for a place will be going to Boreatton Park from Monday 23rd May to Friday 27th May. There will be a meeting nearer the time to discuss anything your child needs or to answer any questions you may have.

Swimming

Year 6 will be attending swimming lessons in the summer term. We are also trying to offer extra swimming lessons to as many children as possible in the run up to this time to ensure that every child can swim 25m (one length) by the time that they leave primary school.

Uniform and Equipment

Please ensure that your child has a water bottle in school so that they can drink regularly throughout the day. **These will now be sent home every day for cleaning.**

Please check that all of your child's uniform and belongings are labelled with their name.

ALL Year 6 children MUST have deodorant in school.

Reading

In preparation for SATs, it is **essential** that you spend time reading with your child at home.

We recommend that your child reads at least 3 to 4 times a week.
