Dear Parents/ Carers,

Many thanks for your patience and cooperation whilst I have been trying to resolve our Dodford Farm booking issues.

I have now managed to re-book Dodford Farm for 22nd March 2021. We are truly hoping we can take the children away on this residential. We are keeping this booking for the current Year 4 as they missed the opportunity to go last year. However, if you would rather your child does not go to Dodford, you can speak to the office to gain a refund via BACS transfer. This transaction must be via BACS so that the school has a record of the refund – we cannot give cash.

I would like to stress, that if several families decide to drop out of this residential due to uncertainty over COVID, this is completely fine but will then mean that I will need to cancel the entire residential as it will not be feasible financially to take only a handful of children away. Again, all families will receive a refund if this is the case. If only one or two children decide to drop out, we can open these spaces up to any children in Year 4 who are not currently going but would like to.
