Safer Schools App

Parents/ Carers- Please download the 'Safer Schools' app on your smart phone.

The Safer Schools App is our school's **digital safeguarding communication and training toolkit**. It has been designed by safeguarding professionals to help make the entire school community safer online. Our Safer School's App will help educate, empower and protect the entire school community.

Login to your App as a parent/carer

1. Select the school from the dropdown menu and click '**continue**'.
2. Enter the **four digit entry code 7440**.



Turn notifications on in your settings to receive important updates about E-safety and social media platforms and learn about what you can do as a parent to keep your children safe whilst online.

The children will also have access to the Safer Schools app on their ipads but will be logged in as a pupil so will receive age appropriate information about keeping safe online. There are also lots of resources they will have access to. This will be done next week.

Free School Meal Vouchers

Please look out on your emails over the next week for a FSM voucher if your child is entitled to them. These are the vouchers that the Government agreed to fund after we had broken up for the October holiday.

These are ONLY for children that are entitled means tested free school meals and NOT all children in Reception/ Year 1 and Year 2 that get UNIVERSAL FSM.

There will be instructions with the vouchers on how to redeem.

Gates

For the safety of everybody, please can you adhere to the signage on the playground gates for entering and exiting the playground. There are now 2 gates either side of the playground.
